



"Hidden in Haarlem" weaves the true stories from an interview with an elder who survived WW II in Holland as a teenager. Many stories tell of war heroes and the persecuted, but this novel aims to bring to light stories of the regular folks who tried their best to bring a horrific war to a close. They went to extremes to survive and help save as many as they could, often at a great personal risk. It is the hope of this author to honor those citizens who have been hidden from the stories of history.

Author S. K. DeMarinis retired after 30 years as a chiropractor and took up writing novels to broaden her passion for storytelling. Actual wartime events and some added fictional characters bring the reader inside history. Fascinated by his tales of resistance as a **citizen saboteur**, Sue further investigated this period of the 20th century. She presents a 1-hour slide show of her research of old newspapers, vintage photos, documents of other survivors, and digital encyclopedia references.


