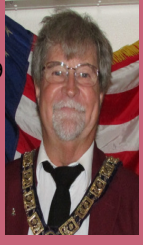

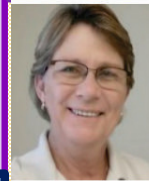


## Brandon Ladies of Elks Lady of Distinction AUGUST

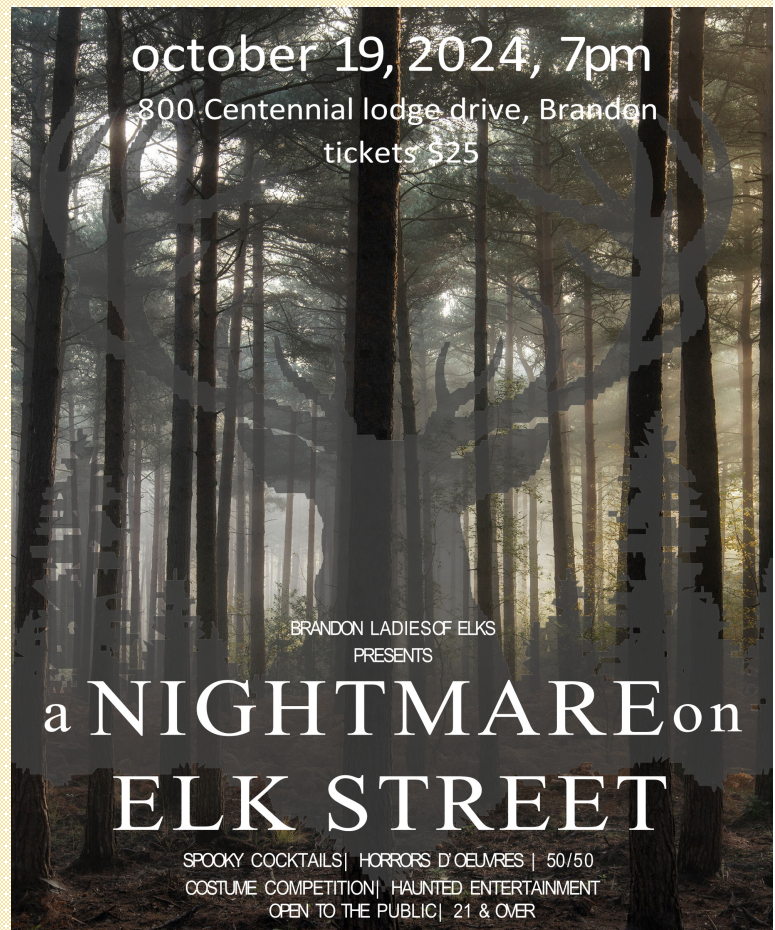


**From the Secretary's Desk**
