MESSAGE FROM YOUR EXALTED RULER, DONALD A HARRISON

The month of February and the upcoming months have a few extra events. In addition to the Friday dinners, the Ladies dinner, Veterans dinner and the Tuesday and Thursday snack bars, we will be having nominations for next year's slate of officers. The positions open for nominations are, The Exalted Ruler, Leading, Loyal, and Lecturing Knights, Treasurer, Secretary, and Five-Year Trustee. To facilitate the election, we have member meetings on the second and fourth Mondays in February, March, and April. Please attend these meetings to meet the potential candidates and to have your vote counted. We are still looking for members to assist in the numerous events we have each month. I have already mentioned the kitchen related activities. We also have car and horse race events in the hall on the calendar in addition to five rentals in these next four months. We have a Valentine dinner/party, a masquerade ball and the PER dinner, a low country boil. The need does not stop with the mentioned events. We need people to assist in stripping and cleaning the kitchen floors, touch-up painting the floors in the cooler and dry storage as well as the back porch. Organizing the storage facilities in the lodge and assisting in generally improving the eye appeal of our lodge. There is an old saying, if you are not growing, you are dying. I am forming a committee to grow membership, the membership committee. The committee's task, to present ideas on how to grow membership and get members involved about 8 hours a month to implement the growth plan. Advertising, membership in community organizations such as the chamber. Direct invitations to businesses that appear to have a mission aligned with our goals, etc. We generally bring in about 40 to 50 new members each year. If those new members were to offer the 8 hours a month for three years, we would have about 12,000 hours a year. Our current use is about 5,500 a year. All this extra labor would allow us to re-engage the community with anti drug programs, scholarships to local students, assistance with food security, expand the rental hall use to generate the revenue to fund these programs, participate in the Fourth of July and other local parades to be seen and many other projects. Growing our participation in projects will grow our lodge and our investment in our community. 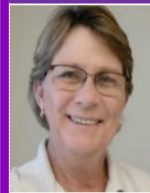
